
# Time of the year to savor Latvian cuisine

<u>Autumn</u> is a time for experiencing nature's bounties and culinary delights. It's the perfect moment to savor beloved Latvian dishes - mushrooms, forest berries, root vegetables - in new forms, by visiting the Autumn Restaurant Weeks held across Latvia.

During the Autumn Restaurant Weeks, a fresh twist is given to beloved and lesser-known vegetables, fruits, berries, and meat sourced from Latvia. We invite you to stay updated on the latest news and visit restaurants in <u>Riga</u> or other regions such as <u>Valmiera</u>, Jelgava, Liepaja, Cesis, Kuldiga, and Sigulda.

Did you know that being in nature and <u>seeking shared</u> <u>adventures</u> is a fantastic team-building activity? Autumn is the perfect time for forest foraging, where groups or individuals can venture into the woods, gather berries and mushrooms, explore nature, and enjoy the touch of fresh air. It's an enlightening activity where you can not only discover nature's treasures but also taste them on a culinary journey at the "<u>Pavāru māja</u>" restaurant.

If you can't find nature's treasures in the forest, you'll definitely find them at one of Latvia's markets – local delicacies, pickled goods, products from farmers, artisan crafts, smoked meats – all of this and more can be experienced by going on a gastronomic tour of one of Latvia's largest markets, Riga Central Market.



<u>Riga Central Market</u> is not only unique with its pavilions but also with its historic warehouses, known as "spīķeri," which have been transformed into a creative industries quarter. In 1998, the territory of Riga Central Market was included in the UNESCO World Heritage List. At Riga Central Market, you can purchase products grown in the Latvian countryside and prepared by local farmers, as well as exotic fruits, spices, and industrial goods. The market consists of five pavilions – vegetable, dairy, meat, fish, and gastronomy – as well as an open-air area with industrial products and artisan crafts, a Night Market, and a Farmers' 24-Hour Market.

For those who appreciate more modern flavors, a visit to Āgenskalns Market is a must. It not only offers a contemporary Latvian taste market pavilion but also features a food court market on the second floor.


## **Fairs and activities**

#### Autumn in Latvia is a stunning display of nature's beauty, with golden hues painting the landscapes and exciting events boosting the nation's spirit.

The contemporary art festival <u>Survival Kit</u> will happen from 7 September till 8 October 2023 in Riga, and it is comprised of a curated exhibition and an event programe. Each year, the festival's appointed curator (or curators) carefully selects the themes explored, inviting artists from around the world to offer alternative scenarios of survival.

The festival's mission to critically investigate and reflect on the evolution of contemporary society has made it a key platform for the Latvian Centre for Contemporary Art (LCCA) to showcase its commitment research, creation. development to and of contemporary art processes in Latvia and internationally since 1993.





The inaugural <u>World Athletics Road</u> <u>Running Championships</u> will take place on 30 September and 1 October 2023 in Riga, being the most significant public sporting and athletics event in the history of the Baltic countries, and that is why call our Capital city 'Riga – World Capital of Running'. The <u>Riga International Film Festival</u> (RIGA IFF) will take place from 12 to 22 October in Riga; it is one of Latvia's premier cultural events, presenting the latest happenings in domestic and global cinema.






